NOT ONE DIME OF PRINCIPAL BUT ITS INCOME REDUCED  
SIGNIFICANTLY BECAUSE OF THE PRESENT LOW INTEREST

RECEIVED 40 REQUESTS FOR GRANTS AND AWARDED 16.  
UNFORTUNATELY THERE WERE 24 DESERVING REQUESTS  
NOT FILLED FOR LACK OF FUNDS

FOR THIS YEAR WE COULD NOT GRANT FUNDS TO 11  
WORTHY PROJECTS. THE LARGE NUMBER OF REQUEST  
COMES FROM A GENERAL TIGHTING OF MONEY FROM  
OTHER SOURCES. IF INTEREST RATES HAD STAYED THE  
SAME AS THEY WERE THE YEAR WE STARTED WE COULD  
MAKE MORE AND/OR LARGER GRANTS

THIS IS JUST ANOTHER SOURCE OF DETERMINATION  
ON THE PART OF THE FUND TO DO ALL IT CAN.

THE 16 GRANTS AWARDED REPRESENT A WIDE  
DIVERSITY OF ARCHAEOLOGY AND THESE  
FOLLOWING SLIDES OF THE GRANTS ILLUSTRATE
