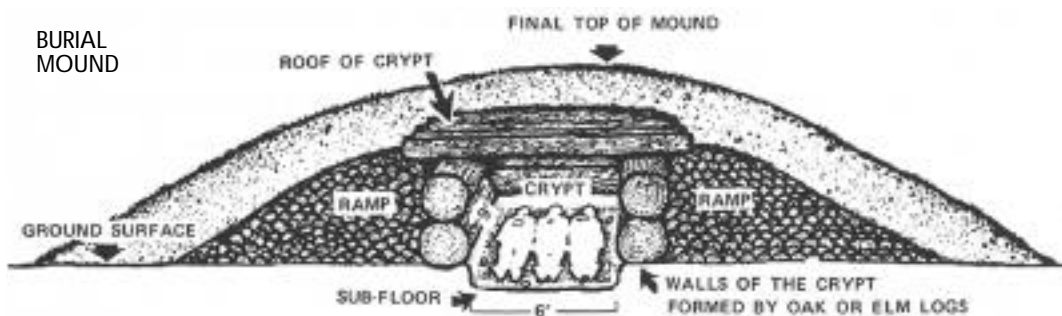

THE ARCHAEOLOGY OF GREGORY PERINO

Gregory Perino contributed much to our understanding of Midwestern prehistory, particularly Woodland and Mississippian cultures. This presentation features his work in the lower Illinois River valley at sites such as Bedford, Montezuma, and Gibson – Middle Woodland mortuary sites. Many of Perino's discoveries, most of which were made in the 1950s and 1960s, remain foundation stones of our understanding of Middle Woodland culture.
